Program Objectives:

- 1) Learn & Practice the fundamentals of golf through PGA professional lessons
- 2) Recognize that players develop golf skills at an individualized pace
- 3) Learn & Practice rules of golf & etiquette
- 4) Provide fun & friendship in a safe & healthy environment for juniors & parents
- 5) Provide friendly competition & prizes

Program Details:

- 1) The Scotch Valley 2009 Junior Golf Program will be held on Wednesdays, June 16<sup>th</sup>, 23<sup>rd</sup> & 30<sup>th</sup>, July 7<sup>th</sup>, 14<sup>th</sup> & 21<sup>st</sup>.
- 2) Lessons for each age group will be as follows
  - a. 2 Hole group – 7:00 p.m. under 8 years old
  - b. 4 Hole group – 6:30 p.m. 8- 11 years old
  - c. 9 Hole group – 6:00 p.m. 12 years & older
  - d. Parents can sign up children also according to playing ability, older children can play with the younger groups and younger children can play with the older groups.
- 3) Lesson Plan
  - a. Wednesday, June 16<sup>th</sup> – Putting, Safety, Etiquette
  - b. Wednesday, June 23<sup>rd</sup> - Chipping & Pitching
  - c. Wednesday, June 30<sup>th</sup> - Full Swing Irons
  - d. Wednesday, July 7<sup>th</sup> - Full Swing Woods
  - e. Wednesday, July 14<sup>th</sup> - Sand Play & Specialty Shots
  - f. Wednesday, July 21<sup>st</sup> - Wrap up & Review
- 4) Dress Code
  - a. Boys & Girls should wear appropriate golf attire at all times
  - b. Denim is not permitted at the Junior Clinics
- 5) Parental involvement
  - a. At least one parent is needed to walk with every junior golf group on the course with exception to an overall monitor for the 9 hole group
  - b. Juniors will not be allowed to play without at least one monitor in every group.
  - c. What is expected of the Monitors
    - i. Ensure the safety of the players
    - ii. Help them with scoring
    - iii. Advise on rules and etiquette
    - iv. Keep pace of play
    - v. Set a good example, watch language, No Smoking is permitted while monitoring the Junior Golf program
    - vi. Encourage and Motivate, but keep lessons to a minimum to keep pace
